*El Jarabe Tapatio*, or Mexican Hat Dance, is a traditional Mexican dance that's often done as part of *Cinco de Mayo*, or Fifth of May, festivals. **Mystery Ensembles**

Musicians make music by playing or singing together in a group or an ensemble. These musicians need your help to know which part to play. The rhythm of each part is described below.
